SEARCH TIPS

- **Keyword Anywhere** will match your terms anywhere in the record, including author, title, subject, series, note, or ISBN/ISSN
- **Subject Keyword** will only search for your terms in the subject fields. Use Library of Congress subject headings only
- **Title Keyword** will only search for your terms in the title field
- Use quotes to search for phrases: "income tax"
- Use ? to truncate terms: **medic?** will retrieve *medicine, medical*, etc.
- Use % to replace a single character: **civili%ation** will retrieve *civilization* and *civilisation*.
- Use + to mark essential terms: **+explorer**
- Use * to mark important terms: ***internet**
- OPTIONAL: Limit your search and retrieve only print books or only Electronic Resources, etc. More search limits are available on the Advanced Search page.

BROWSE TIPS

- Browse searches generate a list to select from:
- Use the **Subject Browse** to view a list of authorized Subject Headings. Use Subject Browse for ideas on how to expand or narrow your topic
- Use the **Author Browse** if you don't have the full name, or are not sure of the correct spelling. Enter last name first
- Use **Call Number Browse** to find a specific book by its classification number, or view a list of books in call number order
- Limits NOT available on Browsers!

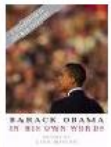
