

Teacher Exchange Leave

The Superintendent/President, or designate, is authorized to give administrative approval to a regular or contract faculty member applying for a faculty exchange leave. The following kinds of leave may be considered for approval.

Leave with salary: In exchange for a faculty member whose salary is paid by the reciprocating school authority.

Leave without salary: When accepting a United States government grant to teach in a national school abroad. The District will compensate the exchange faculty member according to the person's placement on the District salary schedule.

Leave without salary: Accepting a United States government grant to teach in a national school, an American-sponsored school, to study, or conduct research abroad.

If the Superintendent/President, or designate, does not recommend approval for a faculty member who has made application for a faculty exchange, the manager involved shall give to that faculty member a written statement stating the reasons for the denial.
